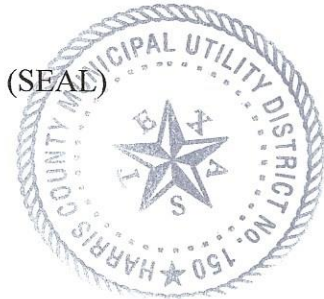
The meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 19, 2019, at 6:00 p.m.

The subject of the meeting will be as follows:

1. Review and consider approval of the minutes of the February 19, 2019, Board of Directors meeting;
2. Consider comments from members of the public, including appeals of District customers;
3. Consider status of the Central Harris County Regional Water Authority;
4. Consider status of web site;
5. Consider garbage collection matters;
6. Consider discussion on and take appropriate action related to landscape maintenance service contract with Yellowstone Landscape, including:
 - a) approval of proposal to replace photinia at Water Plant; and
 - b) approval of proposal to replace wax myrtle at WWTP;
7. Discussion relative to and take appropriate action related to security patrol services within the District, including discussion regarding Harris County Sheriff's Office storefront;
8. Consider report on and take appropriate action related to the status of collection of taxes, and the payment of related invoices;
9. Consider report on status of collection of delinquent taxes;
10. Consider report on and take appropriate action related to the District's water, sanitary sewer and storm sewer systems, including review of customer billing, review of utility operations, repair and maintenance of District facilities, consideration of customer appeals and termination of service to delinquent accounts;
11. Consider review of drought contingency plan and any updates in connection therewith;
12. Consider status of collection of backcharges related to line damage on Veterans Memorial Drive, and take action related to same;

13. Consider comments from Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 217 relative to operation of wastewater treatment plant;
14. Consider status of private detention ponds in District and take action related to same;
15. Consider status of groundwater credits and take action related to same;
16. Consider discussion regarding purchase of property on Veterans Memorial Drive;
17. Consider status of proposed sidewalk project and authorize action relative to same;
18. Consider engineer's report, including:
 - a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District, and take action related to same;
 - b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, and take action related to same;
 - c) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District;
 - d) Review of Capital Improvements Plan;
 - e) Status of Water Plant tank inspections;
 - f) Requests for service, utility commitments, or annexation;
 - g) Discuss lift station on Antoine Drive;
 - h) Status of GIS for the District;
19. Consider review and approval of Resolution Authorizing Use of Surplus Funds, and take action related to same;
20. Consider annual review of Resolution Adopting Prevailing Wage Rate Scale for Construction Projects;
21. Consider status of Bond Application Report in connection with proposed issuance of Bonds by the District, and take action related to same;
22. Consider financial and investment reports, including invoices presented, and take appropriate action related to, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
23. Consider authorizing bookkeeper and tax assessor collector to prepare and file Unclaimed Property Reports prior to July 1, 2019, deadline;
24. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to §551.076 Texas Government Code to deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices, or a security audit;

26. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to §551.071, Texas Government Code to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer;
27. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer;
28. Consideration of matters for possible placement on future agendas.
