Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at 13563 Bammel N. Houston Road, Houston, Texas 77066, said address being a meeting place of the District.

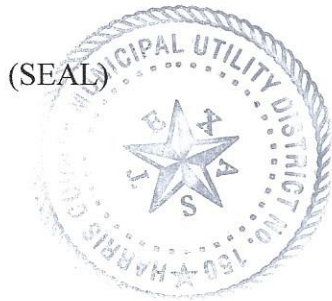
The meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 16, 2019, at 6:00 p.m.

The subject of the meeting will be as follows:

1. Review and consider approval of the minutes of the June 18, 2019 and June 26, 2019, Board of Directors meetings;
2. Consider comments from members of the public, including appeals of District customers;
3. Consider status of the Central Harris County Regional Water Authority;
4. Consider status of and take appropriate action related to contract services from third party vendors, including:
  - a) Website and website services provided by Apollo IT Consulting;
  - b) Solid waste collection services from Best Trash; and
  - c) Landscaping maintenance services from Yellowstone Landscape;
5. Consider discussion relative to and take appropriate action related to security patrol services by Harris County Sheriff;
6. Consider status of and take appropriate action related to interlocal projects with Harris County and/or other entities, including:
  - a) Proposed sidewalk project among the District, HC MUD 217, Spring ISD and Harris County;
  - b) Proposed median beautification project with Harris County; and
  - c) Consider approval of agreement for sponsorship of Water Wise Program with Harris-Galveston Subsidence District;
7. Consider report on and take appropriate action related to the status of collection of taxes, and the payment of related invoices including report on status of collection of delinquent taxes;
8. Consider report on and take appropriate action related to the operation and maintenance of the District's water, sanitary sewer and storm sewer systems, including:
  - a) Review customer billing and collections and facility operations;
  - b) Status of permit compliance, including violation notice from TCEQ for monitoring violation;
  - c) Review activity report for District facilities;
  - d) Status of pending repairs;
  - e) Consider authorizing repairs and/or maintenance of District facilities;

- f) Consider customer appeals;
  - g) Status of backcharges for third-party damages to District facilities;
  - h) Consider termination of service to delinquent accounts;
  - i) Consider approval of commercial meter testing and/or replacement;
  - j) Status of Emergency Preparedness Plan; and
  - k) Status of hydrant painting;
9. Consider comments from Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 217 relative to operation of wastewater treatment plant;
10. Consider status of maintenance of private property maintenance in District and take action related to same;
11. Consider engineer's report, including:
- a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District, and take action related to same;
    - 1) Approval of plans and authorize advertisement for bids for regrading and installation of concrete at WWTP;
    - 2) Approval of plans and authorize advertisement for bids for Water Plant No. 1 Improvements;
    - 3) Approval of plans and authorize advertisement for bids for Elevated Storage Tank Coating;
    - 4) Approval of plans and authorize advertisement for bids for Lift Station No. 2 Rehabilitation;
    - 5) Review bids and award contract for Manhole Rim Replacement project;
    - 6) Status of construction contract with Rally Construction, Inc. for Wastewater Treatment Plant outfall pipe;
  - b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, and take action related to same;
  - c) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District;
  - d) Review of Capital Improvements Plan;
  - e) Requests for service, utility commitments, or annexation;
  - f) Discuss lift station on Antoine Drive;
  - g) Status of GIS for the District;
12. Consider financial and investment reports, including invoices presented, and take appropriate action, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
13. Consider engagement of Arbitrage Compliance Specialists, Inc. relative to the District's Series 2015 Refunding Bonds;

14. Consider request from Northcliffe Manor HOA regarding park area improvements;
15. Consider discussion regarding grocery cart issues in the District;
16. Consider discussion regarding general election matters;
17. Consider update on 86th Texas Legislature;
18. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to §551.076 Texas Government Code to deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices, or a security audit;
19. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices;
